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

#### DIRECTIONS

#### From the East:

Proceed north or south on Route 287 and take Route 1 North Exit. Proceed to Route 1 North for approximately 3 miles to the Gill Lane Exit. Follow Jug Handle to Route1 South. The hotel is immediately on the right.

#### From North:

Take the Garden State Parkway to Exit 131-A. At the fourth traffic light turn right and pass Metropark Train Station on the left. After the third light, turn right onto Gill Lane. The hotel is 1.5 miles further on the right.

#### From Newark International Airport:

Takes Routes 1 and 9 South to Woodbridge. Follow Route 1 South for approximately 12 miles to the hotel.
