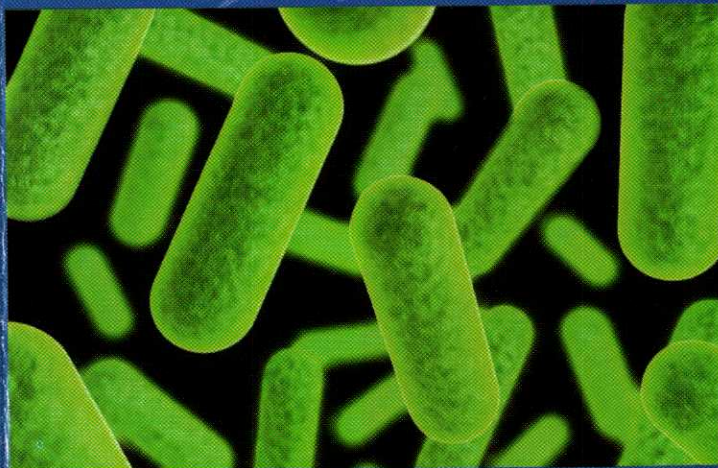

DIRECTIONS

From the East:

Proceed north or south on Route 287 and take Route 1
North Exit. Proceed to Route 1 North for approximately 3
miles to the Gill Lane Exit. Follow Jug Handle to Route 1
South. The hotel is immediately on the right.

From North:

Take the Garden State Parkway to Exit 131-A. At the
fourth traffic light turn right and pass Metropark Train
Station on the left. After the third light, turn right onto
Gill Lane. The hotel is 1.5 miles further on the right.

From Newark International Airport:

Takes Routes 1 and 9 South to Woodbridge. Follow Route
1 South for approximately 12 miles to the hotel.

From the South:

Take the Garden State Parkway to Exit 131-A. Follow the
road to the fourth traffic light and turn right onto the
Middlesex Essex Turnpike. Continue for 3 more traffic
lights and at the third light turn right onto Gill Lane. The
